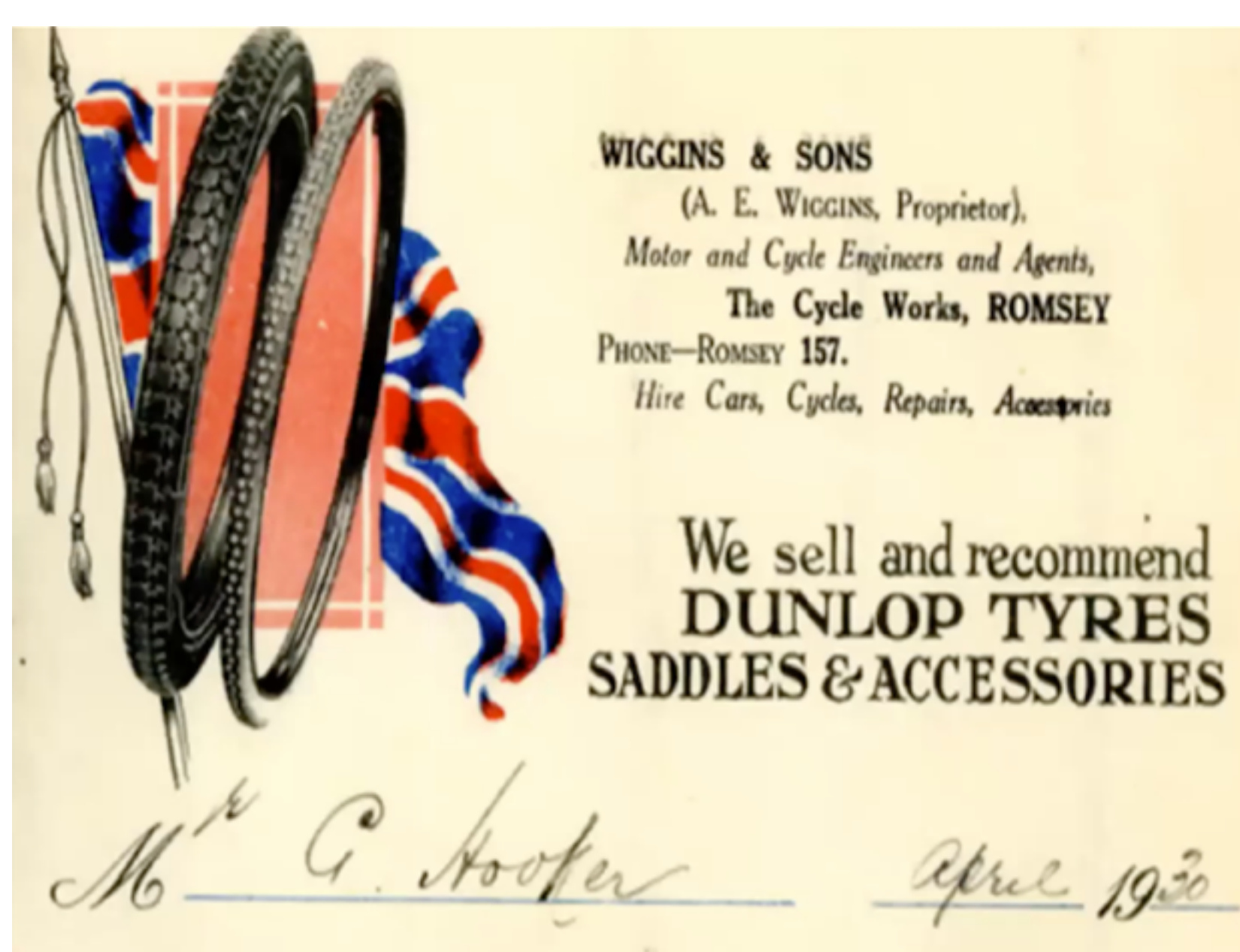


# 11 Market Place



These premises were used by Wheeler, a Tea and Coffee warehouseman in the mid 19th century. He went bankrupt in 1862 and in 1865 Thomas Lampard Powell, undertaker, moved into the premises.



By the beginning of the 20th century it had become a cycle shop. In 1901 it was run by Joseph Haynes, but later the proprietor was Mr Arthur Wiggins.



Ken Davidson sold toys and fishing tackle here but also had another shop in Bell Street.

More recently it was McIlroy's ladies fashion shop. It then became Quality Discounts and is now Tenovus charity shop.
